

ORDINANCE NO: 13**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTIVITIES MADE CRIMES UNDER WISCONSIN STATUTES**

The Town Board of the Town of Grand Rapids, Wisconsin, pursuant to Chapter 299 and § 66.0114 Wisconsin Statutes does ordain as follows with regard to its Town Ordinances:

13.1 Provisions of State Law

13.2 Penalties

Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subjected to a forfeiture per Ordinance 39 "Schedule of Fees and Forfeitures" together with the costs of prosecution.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage and publication as provided by law.
